All Ages

Middle High

Scripture associated with each topic will be read, studied and discussed in a large group setting.

Course Topics

Lesson #1 - Getting Acquainted, Mind Mapping - This icebreaker helps participants learn the importance of knowing and understanding the people they will lead. Participants learn this by getting to know each other as they learn the organizational skill of Mind Mapping.

Lesson #2 - Qualities of a Leader - To get an understanding of the qualities of a leader and relate them to leaders. To learn brainstorming techniques.

Lesson #3 - Public Speaking Tools - The objective of this lesson is to learn the skills of public speaking so you can connect with your audience and get your message across.

Lesson #4 - Leadership Confidence - Students will learn that by following the 3 step process A.C.T. (Action, Courage, Target), they will be able to create the confidence they need for success.

Lesson #5 - Vision, Mission, and Planning - students will learn the difference between the three, how important it is to be passionate about their vision and learn skills necessary to make it a reality.

Lesson #6 - Listening Skills - Leaders must take the time to listen to their people in a way that they feel heard and respected.

Lesson #7 - Building Trust - To get an understanding how a leader can build trust.

Lesson #8 - Understanding Personality Styles - An understanding of the four basic personality styles will help leaders to adjust their own behavior.

What is unique about Impact Leadership Training?

Participants of this event will be able to apply for counselor in training positions at camp. Those who are not old enough for these positions will be able to apply to come to a week of camp to further their leadership skills at a reduced rate. ILT participants will have the opportunity to experience all the fun of camp with their peers!

Cabin Life

During the weekend event students will be housed in one of our lodges divided by gender. Adult supervision will be provided maintaining our adult child ratios.

During one of the two weeks available this summer, participants will either be housed in cabin groups with adult counselors or in cabins with the ILT leadership team, depending on age.
