BEFORE CAMP

Monitor your camper for COVID-19 symptoms for the ten (10) day period leading up to your event.

Medical Form ***required**

- Complete your camper's Health Update Form & bring it with you to Check-In. Campers will not be admitted to camp without a completed Health Update Form. For help, call 888-628-2818.
- Please bring an updated photo of the camper to Check-In.

CHECK-IN

Date: Sunday, June 12
Time: 1:00p-3:00p (EDT)

Designate a pick-up person during Check-In. They'll need a photo ID to pick up your camper.

All medication must be brought in its original labeled container and given to the Camp Medic at Check-In.

**Note: herbal remedies, vitamins, & oils cannot be administered by the camp or counselors without a doctor's note.*

Inhalers, bee-sting kits, and EpiPens will be carried by the camper's counselor. All other medications will be distributed by the Camp Medic.

CHECK-OUT

Date: Friday, June 17
Time: Time: 2:15p (EDT)

Designated pick-up person must show their photo ID.

- If coming from a group home, names or letters will need to be submitted authorizing pick-up people.

Closing Jamboree: 1:15p (EDT)

- Provides a debrief on campers' experiences throughout the week; including how best to extend their faith journey, commitments, & discipleship process at home & with a local church. We invite family & support people to join us for Closing Jamboree.
- Lasts approximately 30 minutes.
- Campers will then head back to the cabins to finish packing before leaving camp.

PACKING GUIDELINES

Helpful Packing Tips:

- Use luggage tags listing the camper's name, address, parent cell & email address
- Pack all items into bags; no loose items.
- Mark all items with your camper's name.
- Use a "stuff" bag, duffle bag, or trash bag for your camper's pillow and sleeping bag, to keep them clean and together.
- Place toiletries in a plastic bag or kit for easy transportation to the showers.
- Pack with your camper so they develop ownership for their items and will know what they have and where to find it.
- Pack plastic or laundry bags for wet/dirty clothing.
- Keep medications separate for easy access during Check-In.

WHAT TO PACK

Bring Things Like This:

- Face masks (optional)
- Shorts, t-shirts, pants, long sleeve shirts, etc.
- Pajamas, underwear, and extra socks
- Modest, weather-appropriate clothing (sweatshirts, jackets, rain gear, etc.)
- Appropriate swimsuit, beach towel, & sunscreen
- Towel, wash cloth, toiletries, and comb/brush
- Sleeping bag/bedding and pillow
- Tennis shoes & flip-flops (for showers/beach)
- Water bottle
- Bug spray with DEET
- Flashlight
- Bible, pen and paper/journal
- Stamped & *Addressed* envelopes
- **An outfit of red, white and blue for our dance party. The theme is: Party in the USA.**

Don't Bring Things Like This:

- Food
- Valuables
- Non-prescription or OTC medications
- Gaming devices, iPads, etc.
- Cell Phones
- Inappropriate clothing (revealing or graphically)
- Knives or weapons of any kind
- Fireworks and other explosives

MEALS

Head east on Highway 30 to Warsaw, IN. Turn left onto E Old Road 30. Turn left onto IN-13 N. Turn right onto Epworth Forest Rd. Continue 1 mile, entrance on right.

From Indianapolis Area

Head North on I-69 toward Ft. Wayne. Take Exit 309B for US 30 W. Continue to Pierceton, IN. Turn right onto IN-13 N. Turn right onto Epworth Forest Road. Continue for 1 mile, camp entrance is on the right.
